and decided what colour paper to use.



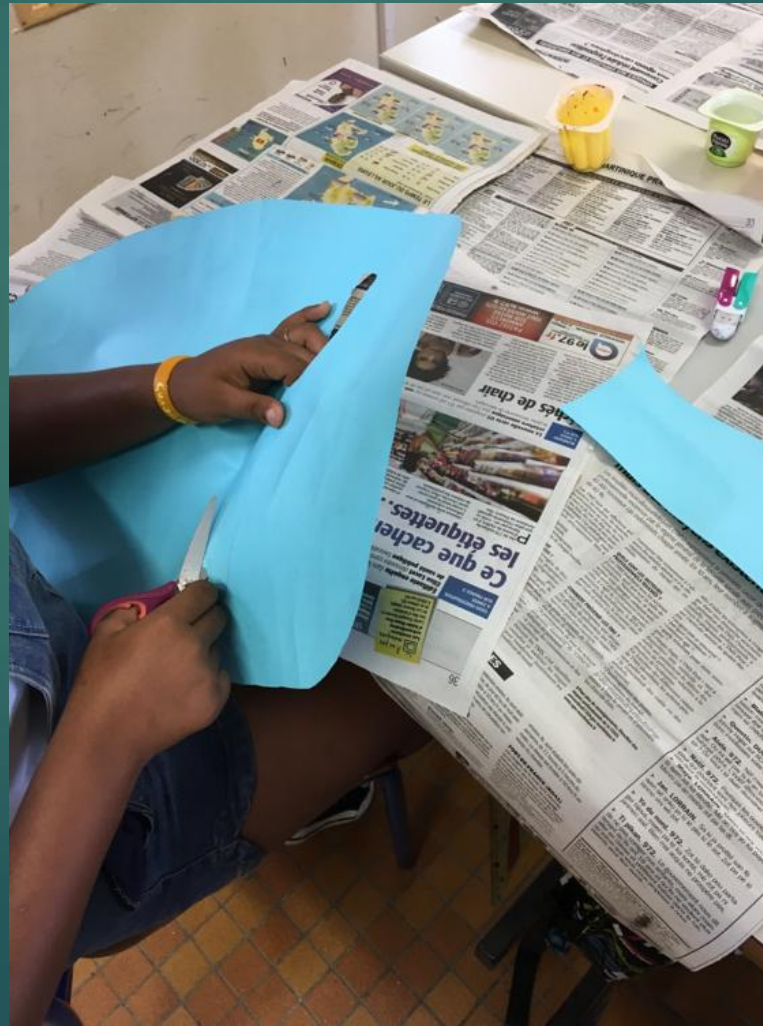
Then we drew the faces and cut them out.

We drew, cut out and painted the eyes



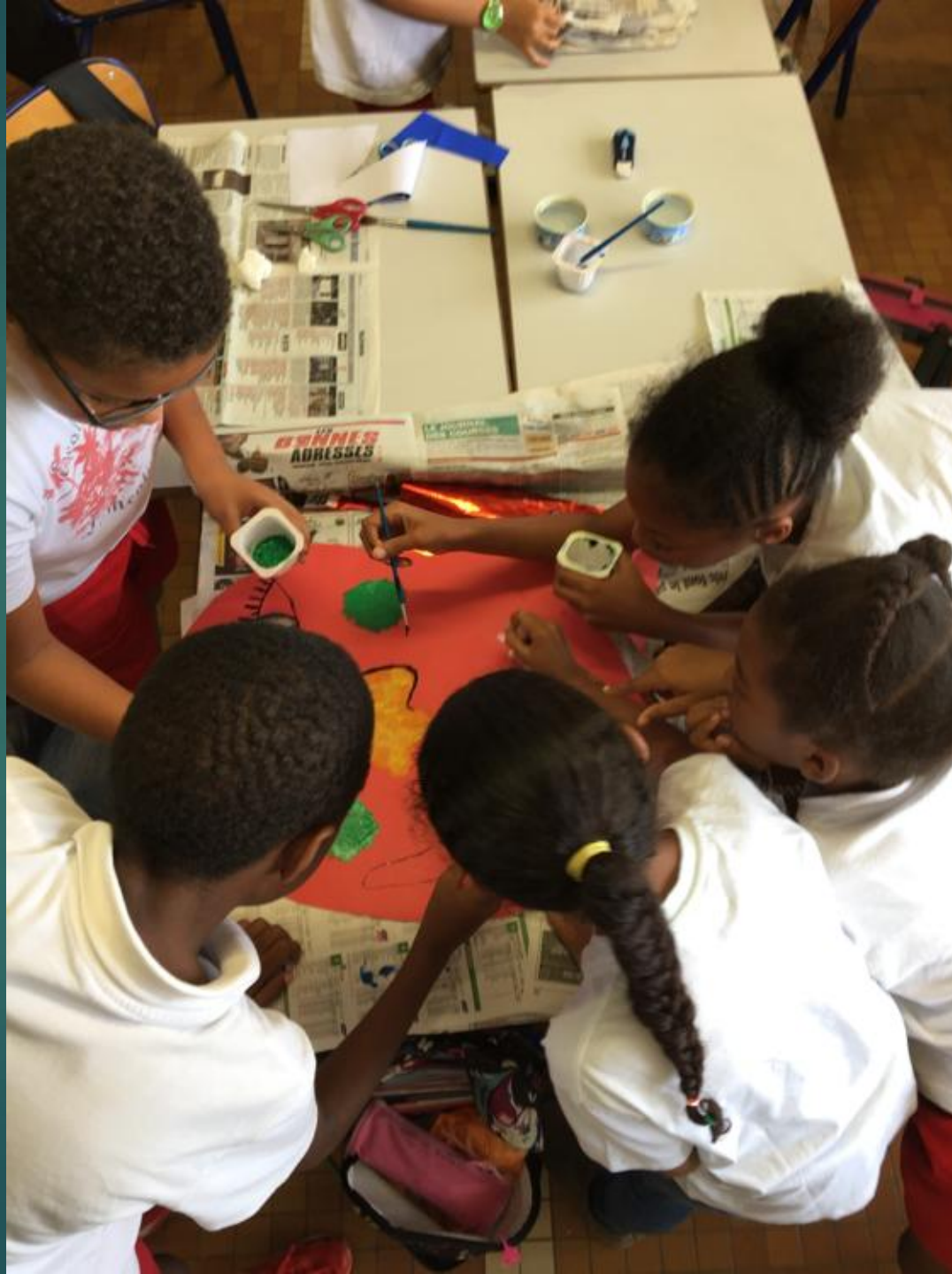
Then we painted noses in different colours.
